"Is It Richly Dwelling Within?"

**"The entrance of Your words gives light; It gives understanding to the simple." (Psalm 119:130)**

Another year of monthly memory verses comes to a close. Does God's word saturate your feeling, thinking, and speaking more now than it did last year?

**JANUARY, Philippians 4:6,7** — Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

**FEBRUARY, Proverbs 1:7** — The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

**MARCH, Hebrews 10:24,25** — And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

**APRIL, Psalm 16:11** — You will show me the path of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy; at Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

**MAY, Deuteronomy 31:6** — Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the LORD your God, He is the One who goes with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you."

**JUNE, Acts 2:38,39** — Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. **AUGUST, Psalm 2:8,9** — Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession. You shall break them with a rod of iron; You shall dash them to pieces like a potter's vessel.

**SEPTEMBER, Isaiah 42:6** — I, the LORD, have called You in righteousness, and will hold Your hand; I will keep You and give You as a covenant to the people, as a light to the Gentiles.

**OCTOBER, 1 Peter 5:6,7** — Humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

**NOVEMBER, Deuteronomy 6:5,6** — Hear, O Israel: the LORD our God, the LORD is one! You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.
