New Life Church Morning Worship March 1, A.D. 2015 Mark 12:28-34 — The Living Sword, Part Four

The word of God is called the sword of the Spirit, and one of Christ's names is the Word of God...He is the living sword! And in Mark 12 we see have seen the living sword flashing in battle against the wicked tenants of His Father's vineyard: Pharisees, scribes, Herodians, and Sadducees.

In today's passage, another scribe (a lawyer, per Matthew's parallel account) questions Jesus. As He did with the question about the resurrection, He takes the opportunity to give some foundational teaching...

I. Verses 1-12, The vineyard owner and his tenants - message of February 1
II. Verses13-17, An entrapment question about taxation - message of February 8
III. Verses 18-27, An entrapment question about resurrection - message of February 22
IV. Verses 28-34, A question from a "Berean" scribe - today's message vs. 34, "...after that no one dared question Him." He now goes on offense!
V. Verses 35-37, Jesus grills them about the Son of David
VI. Verses 28, 40, Jesus rebulses the scribes' hypersist.

VI. Verses 38-40, Jesus rebukes the scribes' hypocrisy VII. Verses 41-44, Jesus commends the sacrificial giving of the widow
